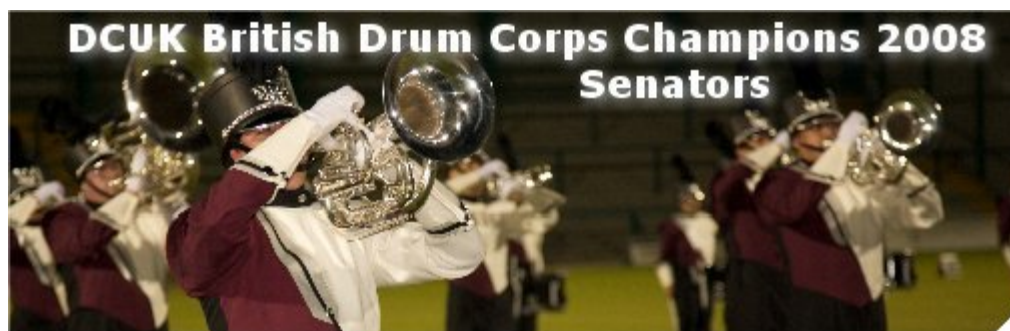

Senators to Facilitate Clinic in Arklow



Irish Marching Band Association in association with the Senators Drum and Bugle Corps are proud to announce that the Senators have agreed to facilitate an open clinic prior to the Arklow DCE IMBA, DCUK show on Saturday 11th July 2009 at the Bridgewater Park Stadium, Arklow.

The major aims of the clinic will be to provide an opportunity to share experiences, knowledge and methods of best practice along with encouraging interaction between all involved in an effort to further embrace closer working relationships while making new friends.

In addition the clinic will give an insight as to how the eight time British and reigning European Drum Corps Champions run their rehearsals with an opportunity to ask questions and receive feedback.

The clinic will run to the following timetable:

4.45pm – 5.00pm

The Senators will perform a number of warm up exercises from the Brass, Battery Percussion, Static Percussion Ensemble and Colour Guard with explanations, commentary methodology relating to the warm ups and exercises being performed.

5.00pm – 5.30pm

The Senators will run a 30-minute full ensemble block covering both audio and visual elements of a segment of the Senators 2009 production "REFLECTION". This session will include explanations and commentary from senior instructional staff of the corps with regards to the reasoning and methodology of various design elements which combine to create the completed production.

Time permitting we would hope to also include a question and answer session.

The Senators and the IMBA would encourage as many people as possible to see this corps in action and to interact with members of the corps with the aim of making new friendships

The clinic will last approx 45 minutes and is open to all member bands. The cost of the clinic is a minimal €1 per band member. Any bands/corps who are interested in attending, please register your numbers by e mailing info@irishmarchingbands.org

Programs will be on sale for €3 each.

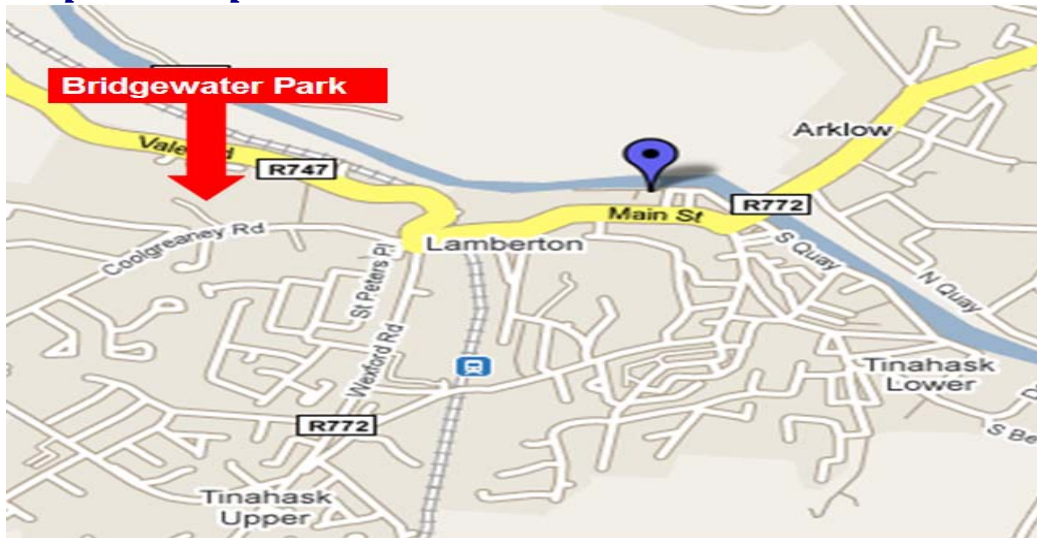
DVD's
