At Exit 9, keep LEFT onto Ramp 0.5 mi M6 / A50 / M62 / Preston / Liverpool / Warrington

Keep LEFT to stay on Ramp 0.6 mi A50 / Warrington

At roundabout, take the FIRST exit onto A50 [Cliff Lane] 0.2 mi

At roundabout, take the SECOND exit onto A50 [Cliff Lane] 2.6 mi

Keep STRAIGHT onto A5061 [Knutsford Road] 0.9 mi

Turn RIGHT (North) onto Miller Street, then immediately turn RIGHT (East) onto

A5061 [Knutsford Road] 0.3 mi

Arrive Knutsford Rd, Latchford, Warrington WA4 1 Vicky Park is on the right.

Admission: Entrance charges (including programme) is £5.00 and £2.00 for children and senior citizens. Free for the under 12s

Parking: There is a large car park next to the Stadium.

Rehearsal Facilities:

There are no changing rooms corps will have to use their coaches. Corps will be able to rehearse on the grass fields surrounding the stadium. Corps may arrive early but may not play until 10.00am. The stadium will be cleared at 11.30 am prior to the competition. In view of the proximity to the stadium noise from the rehearsal area will interfere with the competition so rehearsing must finish by 11.45 am at the very latest. Corps will be advised of a warm up area for use immediately prior to their report time. No playing in the residential areas surrounding the stadium is permitted. Failure to comply with this request will result in the contest being halted.
